Charter of ATME

According to the charter of EUROMIL any military association established on a free democratic basis can become a member of EUROMIL. The member associations are obliged to represent and promote the objectives and the interests of EUROMIL. Amongst others the purpose of EUROMIL is the promotion of fundamental rights and fundamental freedoms in the armed forces as well as the promotion of general, non-material, social and professional interests of active and former service personnel.

The Spanish association ATME advocates the professional, economic and social interests of the members without interfering in political decisions. The main aims of the association as set forth in Art. 6 of the charter comply with the objectives and interests of EUROMIL. Any member of the Spanish Armed Forces with military status can voluntarily join ATME.

ATME is democratically organised. According to the charter the General Assembly is the sovereign and supreme governing body. It meets once a year in an ordinary session and elects the Board (for a period of four years).

According to the charter ATME fulfils the conditions of EUROMIL to become a member.
